

Citizen Appointments to Committees of Council

The City of Brampton is seeking applications from citizens interested in being appointed to the following committees, concurrent with the term of Council, ending November 30, 2014 or until a successor is appointed:

- **Accessibility Advisory Committee (1 vacancy)**
- **Brampton Clean City Committee (2 vacancies)**
- **Brampton Heritage Board (1 vacancy)**
- **Brampton Safety Council (2 vacancies)**
- **Brampton Sports Hall of Fame (1 vacancy)**
- **Churchville Heritage Committee (5 vacancies)**
- **Greater Toronto Airports Authority – Community Environment & Noise Advisory Committee (1 vacancy)**
- **Taxicab Advisory Committee (2 vacancies)**

Accessibility Advisory Committee advises Council on the preparation of an annual accessibility plan as well as accessibility matters pertaining to transit, building and structures. The committee is composed of at least seven members who are persons with disabilities (as defined by the ODA) and up to five other members of the community with preference given to parents and/or caregivers of disabled persons. A vacancy of one member exists at this time.

Brampton Clean City Committee fosters environmental awareness and responsibility; builds neighbourhood and community pride and a sense of ownership; creates opportunities for neighbourhood communities to preserve their environment; and promotes and coordinates opportunities to educate youth and adults about their environment. The committee includes 13 citizen members and two representatives from local business/corporations. Two citizen members are required.

Brampton Heritage Board advises City Council on the identification, conservation and promotion of resources that are identified as being of cultural heritage value or interest. The committee consists of 17 members with one vacancy at this time.

Brampton Safety Council considers matters which relate directly to school safety concerns and pedestrian education. The committee consists of nine citizen members with two vacancies at this time.

Brampton Sports Hall of Fame recognizes and honours the names and deeds of those who have brought fame to the City of Brampton and to themselves through their athletic prowess or contributions to sport. The Board consists of 12 members at large with one current vacancy.

Churchville Heritage Committee monitors the Churchville Heritage Conservation District Plan, acts as liaison for district residents, and participates in the administration of any funding programs for the district. Up to three district residents and up to two members at large are required.

Greater Toronto Airports Authority – Community Environment & Noise Advisory Committee discusses issues relating to the mitigation of aircraft noise in the community and the operation of Toronto Pearson International Airport in an environmentally responsible manner. A vacancy exists for one resident of Brampton.

Taxicab Advisory Committee provides a forum for the various interests of Brampton's taxicab industry to discuss with City Officials identified issues and proposed solutions. The committee includes taxicab industry representatives (drivers, plate owners, brokers). At this time, a vacancy exists for one alternate representative for the taxicab driver position.

Qualifications:

Applicants must be qualified electors in the City of Brampton, i.e., a resident of the City of Brampton, a Canadian citizen and 18 years of age or older.
