

Review of the Policy Governing the Placement of Publication Distribution Boxes on City Streets

Pursuant to By-Law 160-2004, as amended, take notice that the City of Brampton intends to consider a bylaw regulating the placement and securing of newspaper boxes within the City's road allowance. Amendments to the Licensing By-law 1-2002, as amended, and User Fee By-law 380-2003, as amended, are required as well.

EXPLANATORY NOTE

Council will consider a staff report recommending that the current licence process be replaced by a permit system where a permit is issued for each publication distribution box annually instead of a licence issued to a media company for a fleet of boxes.

The recommended permit system will provide a streamlined process with a fee schedule set to recover all associated costs to manage the process.

City Council will consider this matter on **Wednesday, October 10, 2012 at 1:00 p.m.** in the Council Chambers, City Hall. Anyone interested in speaking to this matter or making a written submission, should contact the City Clerk's Office no later than 4:30 p.m., October 9, 2012. In the event that the Committee chooses to refer or defer consideration of the matter, no further public notice will be given.
