

Notice of Intention to Amend Sign By-law 399-2002

Pursuant to Procedure By-Law 160-2004, as amended, take notice that The Corporation of the City of Brampton intends to consider an amendment to the Sign By-law 399-2002, as amended re:

City Wayfinding and Accomplishment Signs

On September 12, 2012, City Council approved a Civic and Community Accomplishment Sign Program to communicate information on provincial, national or international level accomplishments and designations in the City of Brampton. This program identified an initial 17 gateway locations on high traffic Region and City rights-of-way for City branded signs.

An amendment to the Sign By-law is required to permit City-recognized Wayfinding and Accomplishment Signs on road rights-of-way.
