

NOTICE OF INTENTION TO STOP UP AND CLOSE, AND DECLARE SURPLUS A PORTION OF THE ORIGINAL CASTLEMORE ROAD ALLOWANCE

Pursuant to By-law 160-2004, take notice that The Corporation of the City of Brampton intends to stop up and close, and declare surplus a 0.26 acre part of the original Castlemore Road allowance between Lots 10 and 11, Concession 10, Northern Division.

EXPLANATORY NOTE

Following the realignment of Castlemore Road at the intersection with Clarkway Drive, a 0.26 acre, vacant land parcel located within the original Castlemore Road allowance, at the northwest corner of the reconfigured intersection, will become surplus to the City's road requirements, once the newly aligned Castlemore Road is established as public highway. No other municipal use has been identified for the small, irregularly-shaped Road Parcel, which is encumbered by underground utilities.

Committee of Council will consider this matter on October 17, 2012 at 9:30 a.m. in the Council Chambers, Brampton City Hall, at the address noted below. Anyone wishing to be heard regarding this matter should contact, or make written comments to be received in the Clerk's Office on or before 4:30 p.m., October 16, 2012. In the event that the Committee chooses to defer consideration of the matter, no further public notice will be given.
