

**Notice of Intention to Amend User Fee By-law 380-2003  
re: Encroachment Application Fee and Animal Services Fees**

At its meeting on November 28, 2012 at 1:00 p.m., in the Council Chambers, at the address noted below, Brampton City Council will consider the following two matters:

1. a report to introduce an amendment to the User Fee By-law 380-2003 as amended, to implement an encroachment application fee, effective January 1, 2013.

In consideration of the resource demands in processing encroachment requests, staff is recommending an application fee of \$250.00 when a property owner builds / installs / plants objects on City-owned lands.

2. a by-law to amend the User Fee By-law 380-2003 as amended, regarding inspection fees to keep domestic fowl and game fowl, rabbits and pigeons.

It is recommended that the fee for licensing domestic fowl, etc. be set at \$50.00 and that the pigeon fee be increased to the same \$50.00 fee (from \$30.00) in an effort to recoup costs incurred in the process and establish parity for licences for pigeons and domestic fowl, etc. This licensing system also requires inspections by City Animal Services staff. It is recommended that the User Fee By-law be amended to include an inspection fee of \$100.00 to be collected by Animal Services, reflecting the costs for providing the service.

Anyone interested in speaking to these matters or making written submissions should contact the City Clerk's Office no later than 4:30 p.m. on November 27, 2012.

In the event that Council chooses to defer consideration of these matters, no further public notice will be given.
