

Surplus Declaration – Intent to Convey Permanent Easement Rights to Enbridge Gas – Misty Morning Drive

PURSUANT to By-law 160-2004, take notice that The Corporation of the City of Brampton intends to declare surplus and convey the following permanent easement rights to Enbridge Gas Distribution Inc.:

LANDS AFFECTED

- 1) Block 75, Plan 43M-1546, designated as Part 2 on Plan 43R-34786, Brampton (PIN 14220-2066 LT)
- 2) Part 1, Block 78, on draft plan 43R prepared by Schaeffer Dzaldov Bennett Ltd. on November 29, 2012, referenced as Job no. 06-273-09 (PIN 14220-2069 LT)

EXPLANATORY NOTE

Easement rights at the end of Misty Morning Drive (off Airport Road, north of Castlemore Road) are to be conveyed to Enbridge Gas Distribution Inc. for the purposes of installing a gasoline, in accordance with a subdivision agreement with Fernbrook Homes (Castlemore) Limited.

The City's Delegation of Authority By-law 191-2011, authorizes delegation of authority to the City Solicitor and the Commissioner of the operating department, in this case, the Commissioner of Community Services, in connection with the following real estate related activities:

- When the subject property or property right is to be conveyed to a utility for installation/maintenance of services, or the subject property or property right is to be conveyed to another government.
