

Surplus Declaration and Intent to Transfer Permanent Easement Scottsdale Road adjacent to 370 Steeles Avenue West

PURSUANT to By-law 160-2004, take notice that The Corporation of the City of Brampton intends to declare surplus and dispose of the following municipal property:

LANDS AFFECTED

Part of Lot 628, Registered Plan 695, designated as Part 1 on Plan 43R-34732, City of Brampton, Regional Municipality of Peel

The municipal address is Scottsdale Road, adjacent to 370 Steeles Avenue West.

EXPLANATORY NOTE

The transfer of the permanent easement to 574199 Ontario Inc. is for the installation of a watermain and fire hydrant to service the apartment building at 370 Steeles Avenue West, in order to comply with City of Brampton fire safety regulations.

The City's Delegation of Authority By-law 191-2011, authorizes delegation of authority to the City Solicitor and the Commissioner of the operating department, in this case, the Commissioner of Community Services, in connection with the following real estate related activities:
