

DISPOSITION OF LAND
Transfer of Land to the Region of Peel
To Widen Mavis Road, South of Ray Lawson Blvd.

Pursuant to By-Law 160-2004, as amended, take notice that the City of Brampton intends to declare surplus and dispose of the following municipal property:

EXPLANATORY NOTE

Easement rights are to be conveyed over a portion of the subject property, to the Regional Municipality of Peel in connection with the widening of Mavis Road near Rollingwood Drive.

Pursuant to By-law 191-2011, surplus declaration may be made by Delegated Authority. In this case, authority is delegated to the City Solicitor and the Interim Commissioner of Works and Transportation for the following circumstance:

- When the subject property or property right is to be conveyed to a utility for installation / maintenance of services, or the subject property or property right is to be conveyed to another government.
