

## **Notice of Intention to Amend Sign By-law 399-2002**

- 1) Clairville Conservation Authority – 3805 Queen Street East**
- 2) BMO Nesbitt Burns – 111 Queen Street East**

Pursuant to Procedure By-Law 160-2004, as amended, take notice that the Corporation of the City of Brampton intends to consider the following amendments to the Sign By-law 399-2002, as amended:

- 1) A proposed ground sign on the southeast corner of Queen Street East and Clairville Conservation Road. The proposed sign would be located on public lands owned by the Region of Peel. A site-specific amendment to the Sign By-law is required to allow the sign to be placed on the Regional Road right-of-way.
- 2) BMO Nesbitt Burns occupies commercial units in the high rise building located at the southeast corner of Queen Street and James Street. An amendment to the Sign By-law is requested to permit: a) three overhead signs on the north elevation of the 2<sup>nd</sup> floor whereas one is permitted, b) one indirectly illuminated wall sign on the east elevation of the 2<sup>nd</sup> floor whereas none is permitted, and c) backlit illumination of the existing wall sign on the main floor, whereas only indirect lighting is permitted.
