

**Transfer of a Permanent Easement
to the Orangeville Railway Development Corporation
for the Installation of an Underground Cable
Vodden Street West, west of Main Street (Nancy McCredie Park)**

PURSUANT to By-law 160-2004 as amended, take notice that the Corporation of the City of Brampton intends to declare surplus the following municipal property.

LANDS AFFECTED

Part of Block A, Registered Plan M-85, designated as Part 1, 43R-34991, City of Brampton, Regional Municipality of Peel. Located on the south side of Vodden Street West, west of Main Street North (Nancy McCredie Park). PIN 14110-0050.

EXPLANATORY NOTE

Transfer of permanent easement to Orangeville Railway Development Corp. for the installation and maintenance of an underground power cable to operate the railway crossing signals at Vodden Street West.
