

DISPOSITION OF LAND
Conveyance of Land to the Adjacent Property Owner(s)
To Regularize the Rear Fence Line on Gulfbrook Circle

Pursuant to By-Law 160-2004, as amended, take notice that the City of Brampton intends to declare surplus and dispose of the following municipal property:

LANDS AFFECTED

- Part of Block 123, Plan 43M-1880, designated as Parts 1, 2, 3, 4, 5, 6, 7 and 8, 43R-34905, City of Brampton, Regional Municipality of Peel. The PIN of the property is 14226-3217
- Between Highway 410 and Gulfbrook Circle, south of Sandalwood Parkway East

EXPLANATORY NOTE

The reason for this disposition is to regularize the rear fence line of lots on Gulfbrook Circle.

Pursuant to By-law 191-2011, as amended, surplus declaration may be made by Delegated Authority. In this case, authority is delegated to the City Solicitor and the Commissioner of Community Services for the following circumstance:

- The current market value of the property is \$50,000 or less and the surplus declaration was initiated by the City.
