Pursuant to the *Development Charges Act, 1997*, municipalities are required to complete a Background Study before passage of a Development Charges (DC) By-law, which expires after five years. The City's current DC By-Laws will expire on August 5, 2014.

Notice is hereby published that City Council will hold a Special Council Meeting on **Wednesday**, **June 11**, **2014 at 1:00 p.m.** at the address below, to receive public input on its Background Study, in order to consider new Development Charges By-Laws.
