

**Notice of Intention to Amend Sign By-law 399-2002
Peel Memorial Centre for Integrated Health & Wellness
20 Lynch Street – Ward 3**

Pursuant to Procedure By-Law 160-2004, as amended, take notice that the Corporation of the City of Brampton intends to consider site-specific amendments to the Sign By-law 399-2002, as amended.

On **Monday, September 21, 2015 at 1:00 p.m.** in the Council Chambers, City Hall, the Planning & Infrastructure Services Committee will consider a complete package of identification and directional signage for the new Peel Memorial Centre site, proposed by the William Osler Health System:

- 1) Two directional signs – 5.0 m high and 12.72 sq.m. in area
- 2) Three directional signs – 2.44 m high and 2.78 sq.m. in area
- 3) Nine directional signs – 1.5 m high and 0.75 sq.m. in area
- 4) Three entrance canopy mounted signs

While the proposed ground signs and wall signs comply with the City Sign By-law, the size of the building site and the number of restricted access parking areas for staff, patients, visitors and urgent care needs, require directional signs and canopy signs beyond that permitted by the Sign By-law. The proposed signs are necessary to ensure efficient pedestrian and vehicular circulation within the site.
