**Notice of Application for Approval to Expropriate Land
James Potter Road between Queen Street West and Bovaird Drive West**

IN THE MATTER OF an application by The Corporation of the City of Brampton for approval to expropriate all right, title and interest (fee simple) for the purpose of facilitating the construction of a road known as James Potter Road north of Queen Street West and works ancillary thereto, in the lands described as Part of PIN 14094-3207 (LT) being Part of Lot 8, Concession 3, West of Hurontario Street (Chinguacousy), designated as Parts 7, 8, 9, 10, 11, 12, 13, 14 and 15 on Plan 43R-35173 in the City of Brampton.

NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN that application has been made for approval to expropriate all right, title and interest (fee simple) for the purpose of facilitating the construction of a road known as James Potter Road north of Queen Street West and works ancillary thereto, in the lands described as Part of PIN 14094-3207 (LT) being Part of Lot 8, Concession 3, West of Hurontario Street (Chinguacousy), designated as Parts 7, 8, 9, 10, 11, 12, 13, 14 and 15 on Plan 43R-35173 in the City of Brampton.

Any owner of lands in respect of which notice is given who desires an inquiry into whether the taking of such land is fair, sound and reasonably necessary in the achievement of the objectives of the expropriating authority shall so notify the approving authority in writing

- (a) in the case of a registered owner, served personally or by registered mail within thirty (30) days after the registered owner is served with the notice, or, when the registered owner is served by publication, within thirty (30) days after the first publication of the notice;
- (b) in the case of an owner who is not a registered owner, within thirty (30) days after the first publication of the notice.
