

Conveyance of Easement Rights to Hydro One Brampton Three Properties

EXPLANATORY NOTE

Easement rights are to be conveyed over a portion of the subject properties to Hydro One Brampton Networks Inc. in connection with the installation of a switchgear unit.

Pursuant to By-law 191-2011, as amended, surplus declaration may be made by delegated authority, in this circumstance:

- When the subject property or property right is to be conveyed to a utility for installation / maintenance of services.

For these declarations, authority is delegated to the City Solicitor and the Acting Chief Planning and Infrastructure Services Officer.
