## Notice of Intention to Amend Mobile Licensing By-law 67-2014 Refreshment Vehicles and Tow Trucks – Housekeeping Amendments

The City of Brampton intends to amend Mobile Licensing By-law 67-2014, as amended, to address discrepancies and omissions to allow for proper interpretation of the by-law. The amendments are as follows:

- Addition to Appendix E, Threshold Policy of the schedules for Refreshment Vehicles and Tow Trucks;
- Wording changes to clarify Subsection 9(b) and minor changes such as corrected section numbers in Schedule 5, and paragraph re-numbering.
