Surplus Declaration and Disposal of Open Space Land

LANDS AFFECTED

The lands are located South of Highway 407 between Dixie Road and Bramalea Road and is approximately 0.15 acres in size. A site location and key map is included below for reference. The property PIN is 14028-0395 (LT).

EXPLANATORY NOTE

The subject property is non-improved Open Space land and east of Spring Creek. The Property is currently vacant and is not required for municipal purposes.

The Property is currently zoned Flood Plain, designated as Open Space in the Official Plan, and is located in the Parkway Belt Area Secondary Plan.
