Surplus Declaration of Property to Permit the Sale of a Portion of Lower Thames Park to the current owner of 10 Elysian Fields Circle (to correct the side yard set back deficiency as required by the Zoning By-law)

Pursuant to By-law 160-2004, take notice that The Corporation of the City of Brampton intends to declare surplus and sell the following municipal property:

LANDS AFFECTED

The municipal address is 25 Lower Thames Drive ("Lower Thames Park") and is located northwest of the intersection of Financial Drive and Mississauga Road. The lands to be declared surplus total 0.003 acres in size.

The property PIN is 14088-1201(LT). A key map is attached.

EXPLANATORY NOTE

The City owns property located at 25 Lower Thames Drive and the lands to be declared surplus comprise the open space portion located at the southerly end of the park

The Property is currently zoned Open Space in the Zoning By-law, designated Residential in the Official Plan and designated as Brampton West in the Secondary Plan.
