

Notice of Intention to Amend Sign By-law 399-2002 Regulation of Third Party Advertiser Election Signs during an Election Period

Pursuant to Procedure By-Law 160-2004, as amended, take notice that the City of Brampton intends to consider amendments to the Sign By-law 399-2002, as amended, to include election sign regulations applicable to third party advertisers during an election period.

The proposed Sign By-law amendments are to regulate third party advertiser election signs in a similar manner to existing regulations for candidate election signs.

Committee of Council will consider this matter on Wednesday, March 28, 2018, at 9:30 a.m. in the Council Chambers, City Hall.
