



Conveyance of Easement Rights to Alectra Utilities Corporation Lagerfeld Road

PURSUANT to By-law 160-2004, take notice that The Corporation of the City of Brampton intends to declare surplus and convey permanent easement rights over a portion of the following municipal property:

LANDS AFFECTED

Part Block 5, Plan 43M-1927, PIN 14364-2225(LT) and part of Block 18 (0.30 Reserve), Plan 43M-1927, PIN 14364-2238 (LT), City of Brampton, Regional Municipality of Peel, having a municipal address of 0 Lagerfeld Road (Bovaird Drive West and Ashby Field Road).

EXPLANATORY NOTE

Permanent easement rights are to be conveyed to Alectra Utilities Corporation for the purpose of installing, accessing and maintaining a new hydro switchgear vault, over a portion of the lands affected.

Pursuant to By-law 216-2017, surplus declaration may be made by delegated authority, in this circumstance:

• When the subject property or property right is to be conveyed to a utility for installation/maintenance of services.

For this declaration, authority is delegated to the City Solicitor and Commissioner of Public Works and Engineering.
