By-law to facilitate Temporary Outdoor Patio Expansions in an effort to mitigate the effects of COVID-19

Pursuant to By-law 160-2004, as amended, take notice that at its Regular Meeting on Wednesday, June 24, 2020, at 1:00 p.m., City Council will consider, a by-law to facilitate temporary patio expansions in an effort to mitigate the effects of COVID-19. The by-law and the City's **Patio Brampton** Program make it easier for Brampton bars and restaurants to expand their patios and allow for physical distancing as they re-open outdoor dine-in services, once permission is received from the Province.

In consideration of the current COVID-19 public health orders restricting public gatherings and requirements for physical distancing between persons, in-person attendance at this Regular Council meeting will be limited to Members of Council and essential City staff only.
