




Purpose and Effect

The purpose of the application is to amend the Zoning By-law to facilitate the development of a truck wash and repair facility with offices/warehouse area and ancillary truck and trailer parking.

The building will be located along Goreway Drive and the trailer parking will be located adjacent to Deerhurst Drove, with an entrance to the truck parking to be along Deerhurst Drive.

The subject property is located on the northeast corner of Goreway Drive and Intermodal Drive and is municipally known as 0 Goreway Drive.

Important Information about making a submission

If a person or public body does not make oral submissions at a public meeting or make written submissions to the City of Brampton with respect to a proposed Official Plan Amendment or proposed Zoning By-law Amendment before a Zoning By-law is passed, or before a proposed Official Olan Amendment is adopted:

- (a) The person or public body is not entitled to appeal the decision of the City of Brampton to the Local Planning Appeal Tribunal; and,
- (b) The person or public body may not be added as a party to the hearing of an appeal before the Local Planning Appeal Tribunal unless, in the opinion of the Tribunal, there are reasonable grounds to do so.



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
