

Purpose and Effect

This plan of subdivision application proposes to develop single-detached residential dwellings (15 lots), a Natural Heritage System channel, and the extension of Hosta Street to Creditview Road. An associated amendment to the Zoning By-law to facilitate this proposal has also been submitted.

The property is located on the west side of Creditview Road, south of Fallowfield Road. It is known municipally as 9074 and 9084 Creditview Road.


Important Information about making a submission

If a person or public body does not make oral submissions at a public meeting or make written submissions to the City Clerk with respect to a proposed plan of subdivision, proposed official plan amendment or proposed zoning by-law amendment before the City gives or refuses to give approval to the draft plan of subdivision, or before a zoning by-law is passed, or before a proposed official plan amendment is adopted:

- (a) The person or public body is not entitled to appeal the decision of the City of Brampton to the Ontario Municipal Board; and,
- (b) The person or public body may not be added as a party to the hearing of an appeal before the Ontario Municipal Board unless, in the opinion of the Board, there are reasonable grounds to do so.
