

**Notice of Intent to Pass a By-law  
Local Improvement Work under Ontario Regulation 586/06 of the *Municipal Act, 2001*  
Construction of a “Noise Attenuation Barrier” on City Property  
East Side of Bramalea Road between 22 Pepperwood Place and 2 Trillium Court**

Take notice that Committee of Council, at its February 1, 2012 meeting at 9:30 am, at the address below, will consider a report and draft by-law to undertake the following work as a local improvement under Ontario Regulation 586/06 (“the Regulation”) of the *Municipal Act, 2001*:

- Construction of a noise attenuation barrier (i.e., “noise wall”) on the City right-of-way known as Bramalea Road between 22 Pepperwood Place and 2 Trillium Court, affecting the properties municipally known as:
  - 22 and 24 Pepperwood Place, and
  - 2 Trillium Court.

The total cost of the work is estimated to be \$144,653.00. The estimated lifetime of the design and construction of the noise wall is expected to be 25 years.

Based on a 75/25 cost sharing arrangement between The Corporation of the City of Brampton and the properties, the property owner’s share per metre of frontage is estimated at \$425.00 per metre.

The estimated special charge will be payable by the affected property owners via a Local Improvement tax roll assessed to affected properties and payable to the City immediately upon completion of the work or in annual installments over a 15 year period.

The City Clerk has certified that the petition in favour of this local improvement has met the minimum requirements for a valid petition under the Regulation.

In the event that Committee of Council chooses to refer or defer consideration of this matter, no further public notice will be given.
