

DISPOSITION OF LAND
Transfer of Land to the Region of Peel
To Widen Mississauga Road from Queen Street to Bovaird Drive

Pursuant to By-Law 160-2004, as amended, take notice that the City of Brampton intends to declare surplus and dispose of the following municipal property:

LANDS AFFECTED

- Part of Lot 6, Concession 5, W.H.S. and Part of Block D, Plan M-337, City of Brampton, Regional Municipality of Peel, being Parts 1, 2 and 3 on Plan 43R-33564. The municipal address of the subject property is 9126 Mississauga Road.

EXPLANATORY NOTE

Transfer of the fee simple interest to the Region of Peel for the widening of Mississauga Road from Queen Street to Bovaird Drive.
