

**Transfer of a Permanent Easement to Orangeville Railway Development Corp.
For the Installation of an Underground Cable
South Side of Williams Parkway West, west of Main Street (Burton Court Park)**

PURSUANT to By-law 160-2004 as amended, take notice that the Corporation of the City of Brampton intends to declare surplus the following municipal property:

LANDS AFFECTED

Part of Block C, Registered Plan M-169, designated as Part 1, 43R-34189, City of Brampton, Regional Municipality of Peel.

EXPLANATORY NOTE

Transfer of permanent easement to Orangeville Railway Development Corporation for the installation and maintenance of an underground cable to operate the railway crossing signals at Williams Parkway West.
