

**Notice of Passing of a Zoning By-law to Permit City of Brampton
Public Uses and Region of Peel Emergency Health Services and
Police Protection Uses in All Zones – All Wards**

TAKE NOTICE that Brampton Council passed By-law 332-2011 on December 14, 2011, under section 34 of the *Planning Act*, RSO 1990 c.P.13, with respect to a City Initiated Amendment to permit Brampton Public Uses and Region of Peel Emergency Health Services and Police and Police Protection Uses in All Zones – All Wards (File CI11.002)

AND TAKE NOTICE that only individuals, corporations and public bodies may appeal a zoning by-law to the Ontario Municipal Board (OMB). A notice of appeal may not be filed by an unincorporated association or group. However, a notice of appeal may be filed in the name of an individual who is a member of the association or the group on its behalf.

To appeal this zoning by-law **a notice of appeal** must be filed with the City Clerk, at the address noted below, **no later than January 11, 2012**. A copy of an appeal form is available from the OMB website at www.omb.gov.on.ca or by contacting the City Clerk.

The Notice of Appeal must:

- (1) be in writing; and,
- (2) set out the reasons for appeal; and,
- (3) be accompanied by the fee prescribed under the *Ontario Municipal Board Act* in the amount of \$125.00 payable by certified cheque or money order to the Minister of Finance, Province of Ontario.

No person or public body shall be added as a party to the hearing of the appeal unless, before the by-law was passed, the person or public body made oral submissions at a public meeting or written submissions to the Council or, in the opinion of the Ontario Municipal Board, there are reasonable grounds to add the person or public body as a party.

An explanation of the purpose and effect of the by-law is provided. The complete by-law is available for inspection in the City Clerk's Office during regular office hours. A key map is not available as the by-law is in effect for all of City of Brampton.
