

## NOTICE OF PASSING

**A Bylaw to Amend Development Charges By-law 227-2009,  
as amended by By-laws 230-2010 and 167-2011,  
pertaining to Roads (Industrial and Office Discount Rates)**

The Council of the Corporation of the City of Brampton, at a Council Meeting held on June 20, 2012, passed **By-law 185-2012**. This by-law extends the Industrial and Office Development Charge discount to August 5, 2013. The City has also approved a new discount for "Full Service Hotels".

Any person or organization may appeal to the Ontario Municipal Board under section 14 of the *Development Charges Act, 1997*, in respect of this by-law by filing a notice of appeal with the Clerk of the City of Brampton at the address noted below, which notice shall be received no later than 4:30 p.m. on July 31, 2012.

The Notice of Appeal must:

- (1) be in writing;
- (2) set out the objection to the by-law and the reasons supporting the objection;  
and
- (3) be accompanied by the fee prescribed under the Ontario Municipal Board Act in the amount of \$125.00 payable by certified cheque or money order to the Minister of Finance, Province of Ontario.

The by-laws affect all lands in the City of Brampton so no key map is provided to show the lands to which the by-laws apply.
