


# LET'S CONJECT

#### **Purpose and Effect**

In December 2009, Council authorized staff to initiate secondary planning for Secondary Plan Areas 52 (Huttonville North) & 53 (Mount Pleasant West), collectively referred to as the "Heritage Heights Community". The City held an open house meeting in November 2012 to present a draft Preliminary Concept Plan.

The purpose of this open house meeting is to present a revised Land Use Concept Plan (dated May 2014) for Secondary Plan Areas 52 and 53. The Land Use Concept Plan has been updated to incorporate findings from the various secondary plan component studies.

The May 2014 Land Use Concept Plan identifies a potential location of the GTA West Corridor, a natural heritage system, a transportation network, preliminary retail sites and employment lands, schools and places of worship.
