By resolution passed at it's meeting on February 28, 2024, Brampton City Council has created the new Brampton Women's Advisory Committee (BWAC) with a purpose to: support the City of Brampton commitment to creating a gender-inclusive municipality and fostering meaningful participation of women across the organization. The BWAC aims to raise awareness, advise, and stimulate action to serve as a resource to Council on matters pertaining to women in the City of Brampton, and will consider the unique socioeconomic, political, and cultural barriers that women may face because of public policy mandates.
