Proposed amendment to Business Licensing By-law 332-2013

Pursuant to By-law 160-2004, as amended, take notice that at its meeting on Wednesday, October 11, 2023, at 9:30 a.m., in the Council Chambers at City Hall, Committee of Council will consider a proposed by-law to:

- Repeal and replace <u>Business Licensing By-law 332-2013</u>, resulting from a comprehensive review of the existing by-law provisions.
- Inclusion of new business licence categories including, outdoor storage facilities, pet grooming businesses, caterers, and out-of-town car rentals.
- Transfer of business licence provisions for animal kennels and doggie daycares from the <u>Dog Licence By-law 250-2005</u> and <u>User Fee By-law 380-2003</u> to the new Business Licensing By-law.
- Inclusion on annual business licence fee increases, based on the Consumer Price Index, starting in 2025.
