

Notice of Intention to Amend Business Licensing By-law 332-2013 to amend the definition of “Lodging House” in Schedule 17

Pursuant to Procedure By-law 160-2004, as amended, take notice that the City of Brampton intends to consider an amendment to Business Licensing By-law 332-2013, as amended.

On Monday, October 26, 2020, at 7:00 p.m., via regular meeting with electronic participation, the Planning and Development Committee will consider the following proposed amendment to the Business Licensing By-law:

- amend schedule 17 relating to Lodging Houses by amending the definition of “Lodging House” to change the number of lodgers from “3 or more” to “more than 4”.

In consideration of the current COVID-19 public health orders prohibiting large public gatherings and requirements for physical distancing between persons, in-person attendance at this Committee meeting will be limited to Members of Council and essential City staff.
