

## City of Brampton Second Units Policy Review Open Houses

In 2011 the Province of Ontario passed Bill 140, the *Strong Communities Through Affordable Housing Act*. The Act includes a requirement for municipalities to implement policies in their Official Plans and regulations in their Zoning By-laws to permit second units in detached, semi-detached and townhouse dwellings.

Second units (also known as accessory or basement apartments, secondary suites/units, two-unit housing, “granny flats” and inlaw flats) are typically defined as self-contained residential units with kitchen and bathroom facilities within a dwelling or within a structure accessory to a dwelling.
