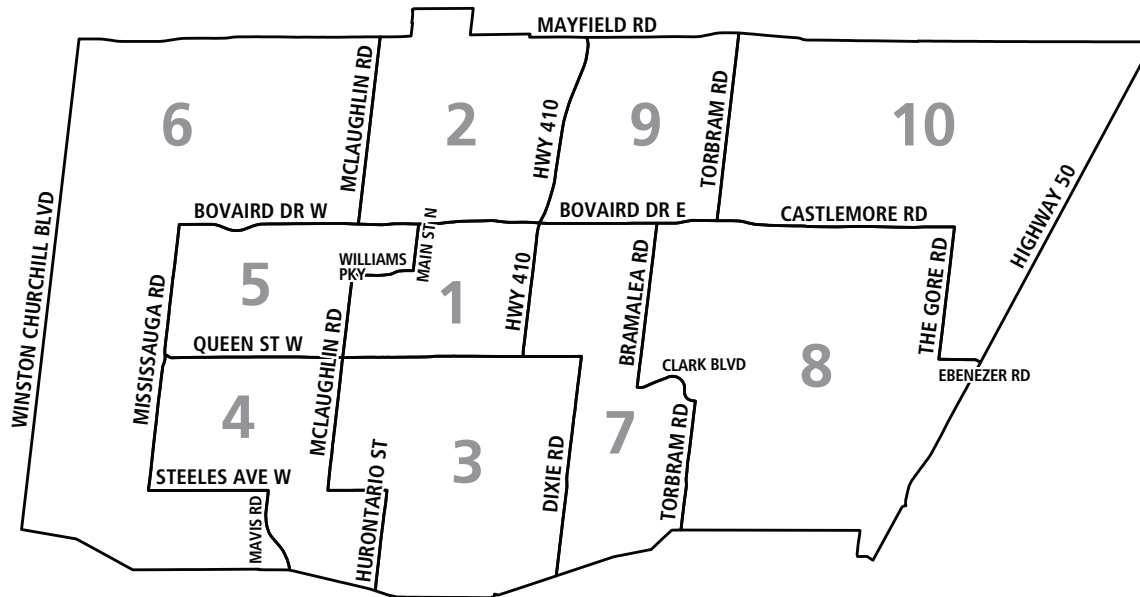




# Public Notice

## NEW MUNICIPAL WARD BOUNDARIES TO TAKE EFFECT FOR THE 2014 MUNICIPAL ELECTION

The Council of the City of Brampton at their meeting on March 27, 2013, passed By-law 66-2013 that re-divides the existing 10 wards into 10 new wards to provide for relatively equal and effective representation (see map below). This is in accordance with Section 222 of the Municipal Act, 2001. This change will take effect for the 2014 Municipal Election.



### Appeal process

Any person or agency who objects to the new ward boundary structure, may appeal to the Ontario Municipal Board by filing a Notice of Appeal **no later than 4:30 pm on May 13, 2013.**

The Notice of Appeal must:

- (1) be filed in writing with the City Clerk at the address noted below;
- (2) set out the reasons for the appeal; and
- (3) be accompanied by the fee prescribed under the Ontario Municipal Board Act in the amount of \$125.00 payable by certified cheque or money order to the Minister of Finance, Ontario.
