

INDEPENDENT AUDITOR'S REPORT

To the Clerk of the City of Brampton,

Report on the Financial statements

I have audited the accompanying statement of Income and expense – Auditors report candidate – form 4 for Simrohit Sidhu, candidate , campaign period from July 26, 2018 to December 31, 2018.

Candidates responsibility for the financial statements

The candidate is responsible for the preparation and fair representation of the financial statements in accordance with the accounting procedures established by the Municipal Elections act, 1996, and for such internal control as the candidate determines is necessary to enable the preparation of the financial statements that are free from material misstatements due to fraud or error.

Auditor's Responsibility

My responsibility is to express an opinion on these financial statements based on my audit. I conducted my audit in accordance with Canadian generally accepted auditing standards. Those standards require that I comply with ethical requirements, and plan and perform the audit to obtain reasonable assurance about whether the financial statements are free from material misstatement.

An audit involves performing procedures to obtain audit evidence about the amounts and disclosures in the financial statements. The procedures selected depend on the auditor's judgement, including the assessment of the risks of material misstatement of the financial statements, whether due to fraud or error. In making those risk assessments, the auditor considers internal control relevant to the candidate's preparation of the financial statements in order to design audit procedures that are appropriate in the circumstances, but not for the purpose of expressing an opinion on the effectiveness of the candidate's internal controls. An audit also includes evaluating the appropriateness of accounting policies used and the reasonableness of accounting estimates made by the candidate, as well as evaluating the overall presentation of the financial statements.

I believe that the audit evidence I have obtained is sufficient and appropriate to provide a basis for my qualified audit opinion.

Basis for Qualified Opinion

Due to the inherent nature of the transactions of an election campaign, it is impracticable through auditing procedures to determine that the accounting records include all donations of goods and services, and receipts and disbursements. Accordingly, my verification of these amounts was limited to ensuring that the financial statements reflect the amounts recorded in the accounting records of Simrohit Sidhu candidate , in accordance with the accounting procedures established by the municipal elections act, 1996 and I was not able to determine whether any adjustments might be necessary to contributions and other revenue, expenses, assets, liabilities and net assets.

Qualified Opinion

In my opinion, except for the effect of adjustments, if any which might have determined to be necessary had I been able to satisfy myself as to the completeness of the records as described in the preceding paragraph, the financial statements present fairly, in all material respects the financial position of the candidate's election campaign as at December 31, 2018 and the income and expenses for the campaign period, July 26, 2018 to December 31, 2018 and the determination of surplus or deficit and the disposition of the surplus in accordance with the accounting treatment prescribed by the Municipal elections Act, 1996.
