





Average Length of Heat Waves


+ 35% (2023-2050) + 167% (2023-2095)

The number of hot nights is going to double in the next two decades.












THREE LANDSCAPES

The building's arcing form creates a radial geometry for the site design, defining three park zones oriented to the street, pond and neighbourhood.



DESIRE LINES

Desire lines and neighbourhood connections are prioritized across the site, allowing for easy access to and from the surrounding context.



INTERIOR-EXTERIOR CONNECTIVITY

The central lobby will be a new activity hub for the community, connecting the building interior to the exterior park beyond.





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
Level 01 Plan






North East facade. Pedestrians have views into aquatics as they walk along promenade to the central lobby and outdoor park
