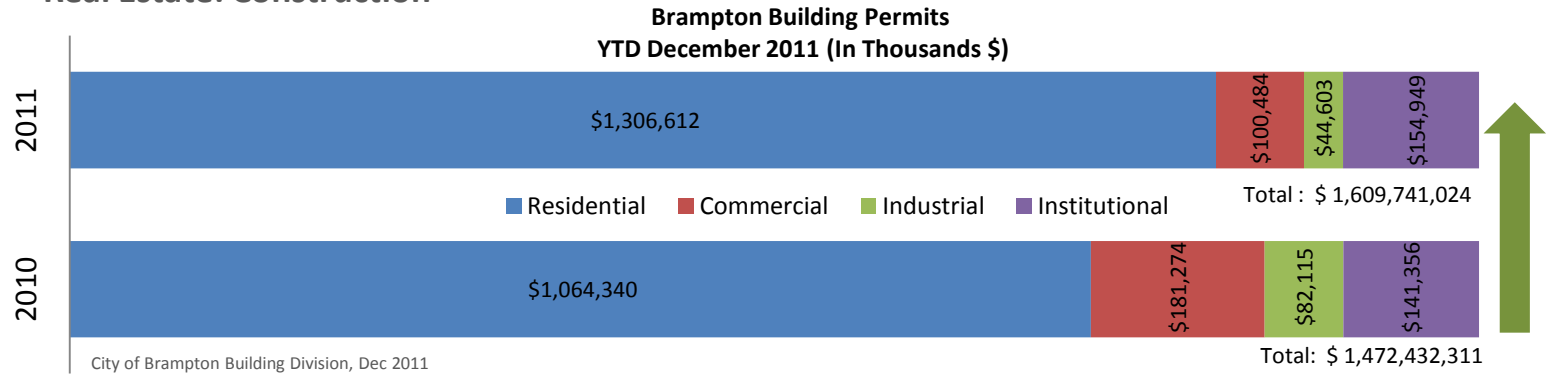

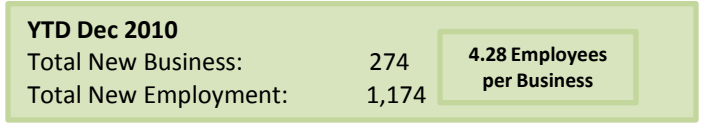
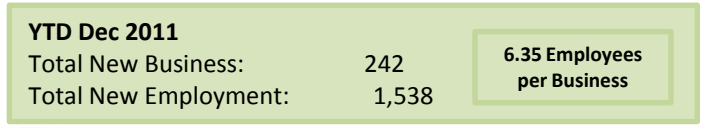
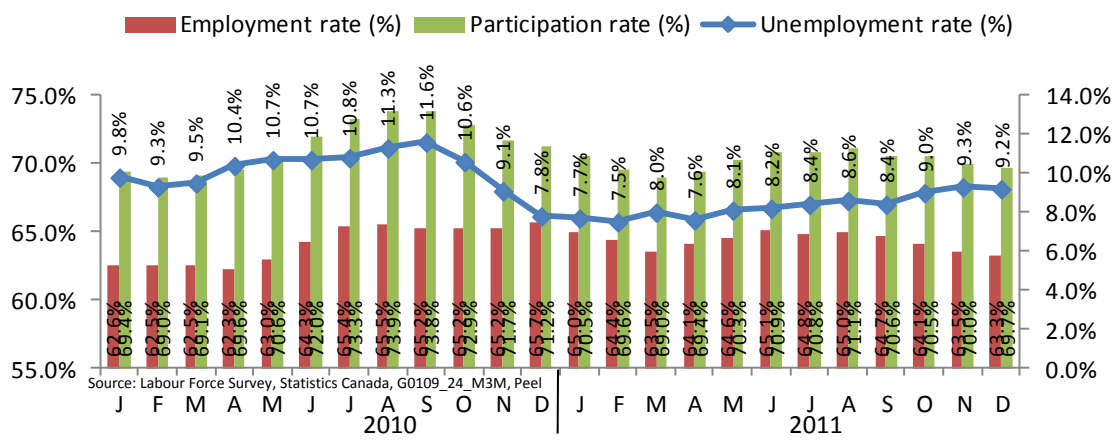
Real Estate: Residential
