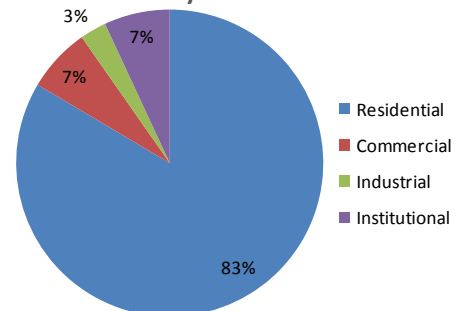

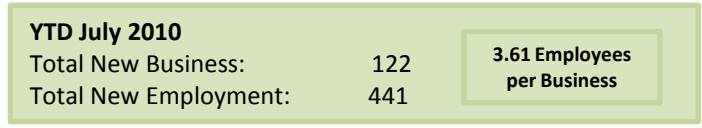
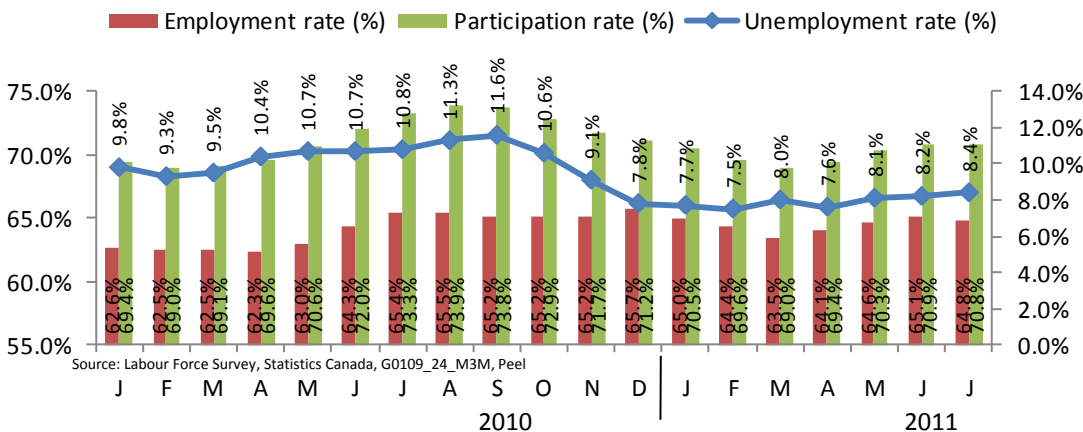
Real Estate: Residential
