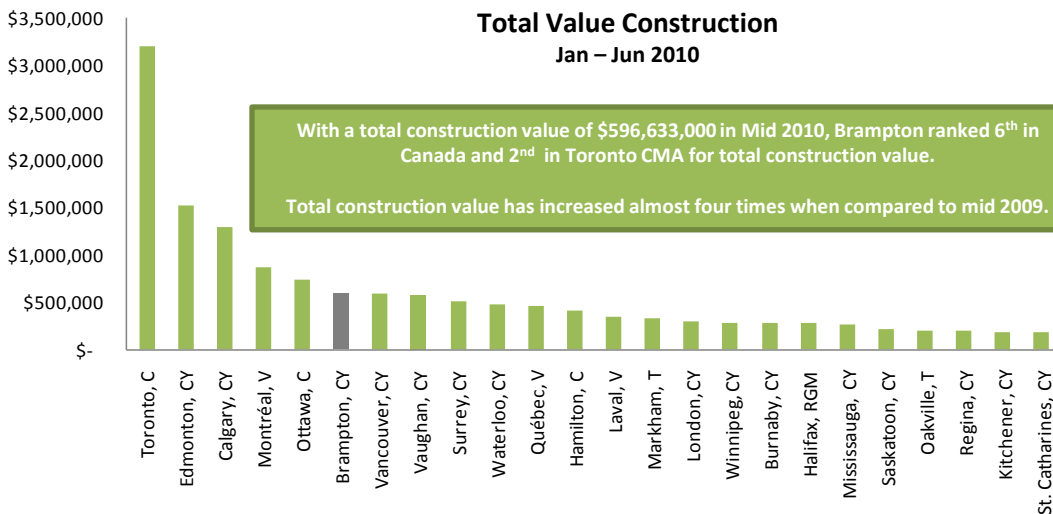

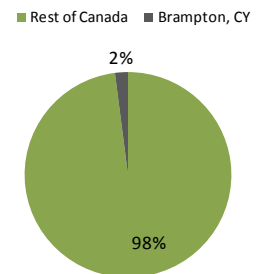

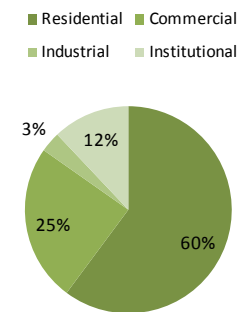
Featured Indicator: National Building Permit Ranking⁶

Brampton Total Construction Breakdown



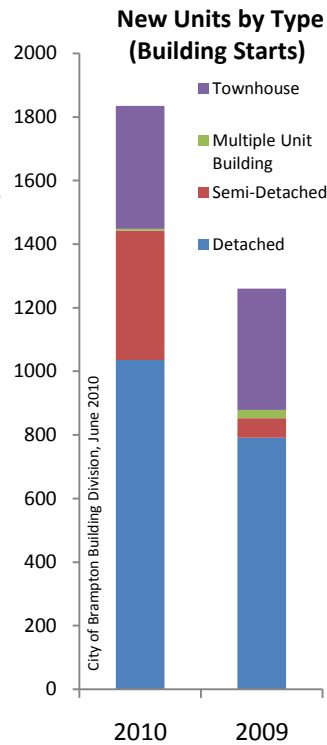
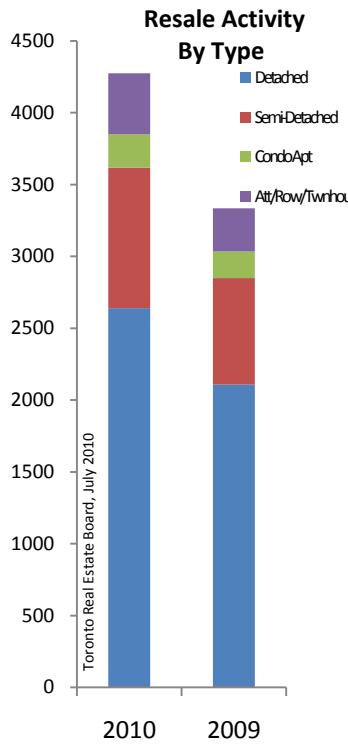
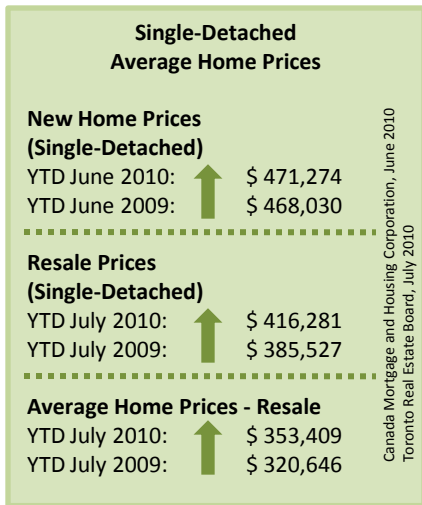

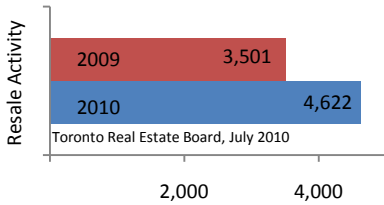

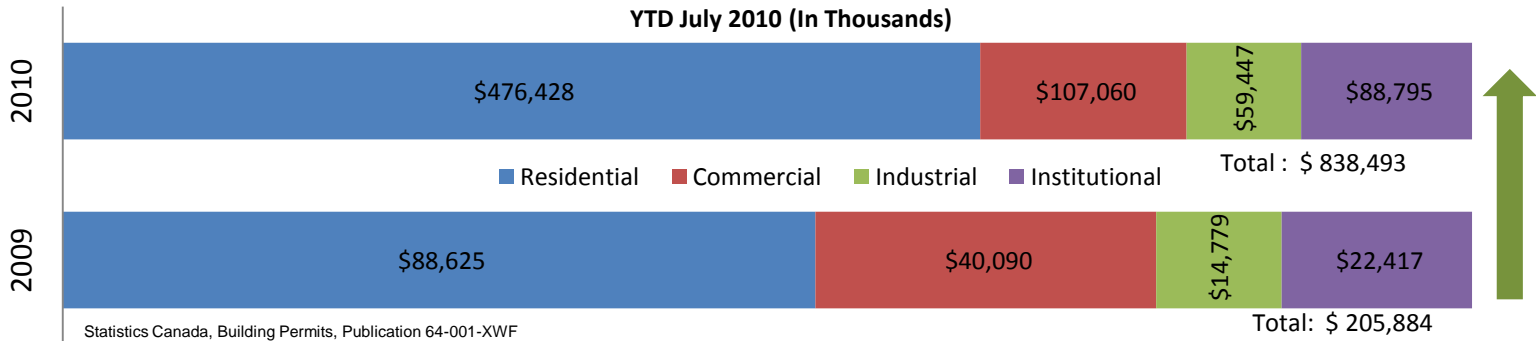


Absorbed Single Detached Units by Price (\$) Range, Brampton, 2010 June (YTD)

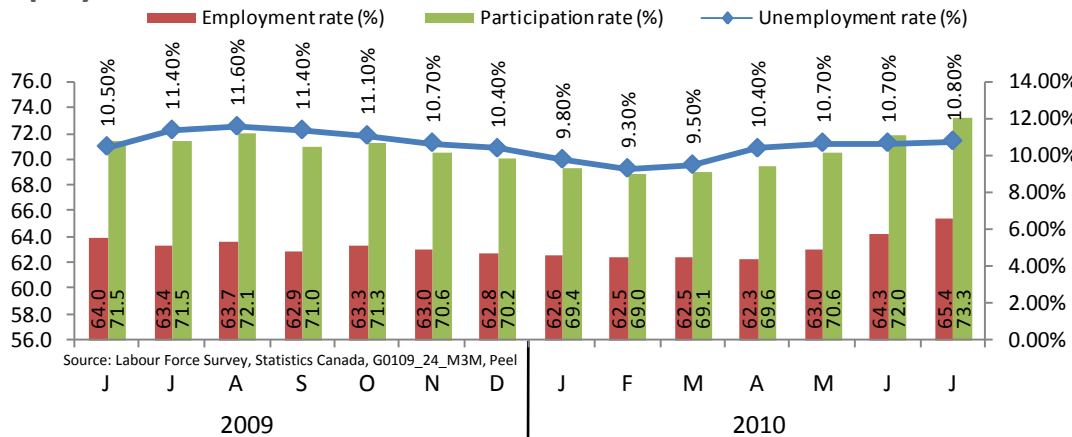

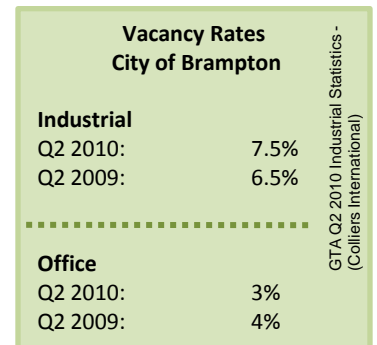
Brampton Building Permits YTD July 2010 (In Thousands)
