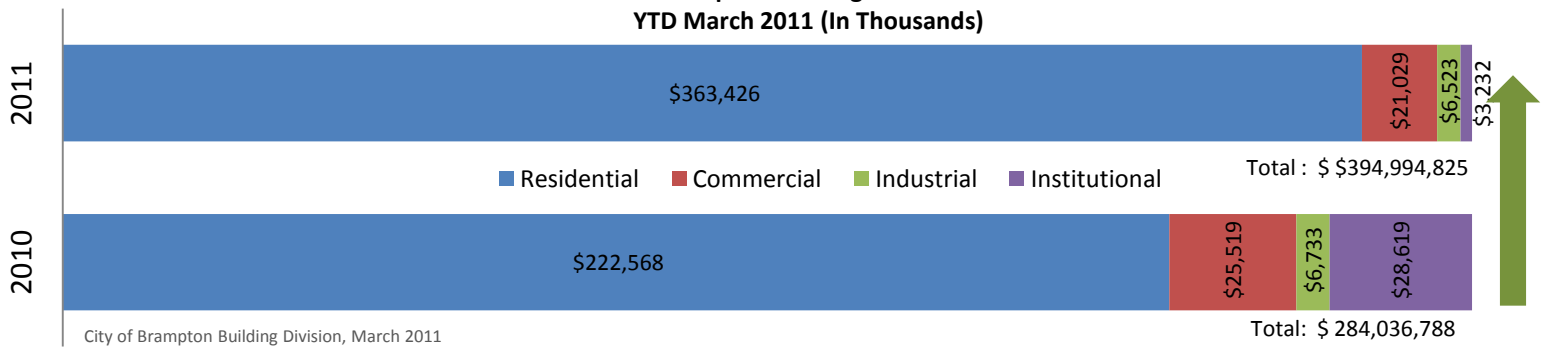


New Single Detached Units by Price 2011 February (YTD)

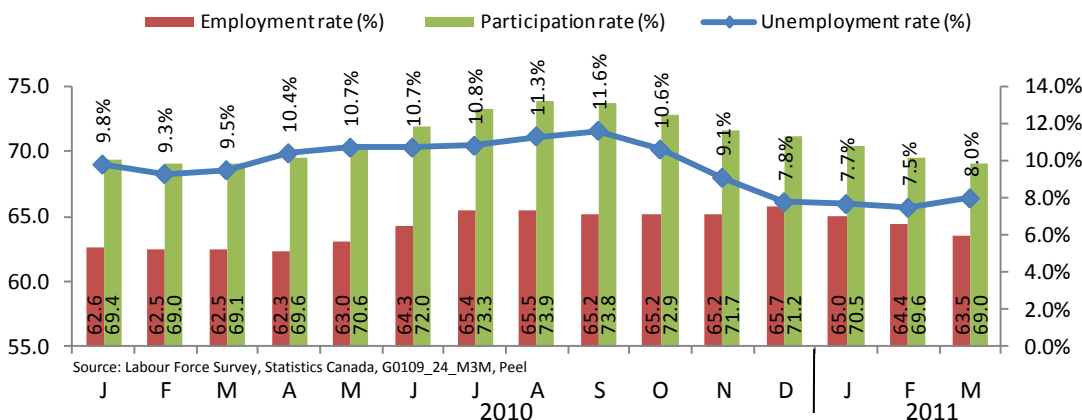

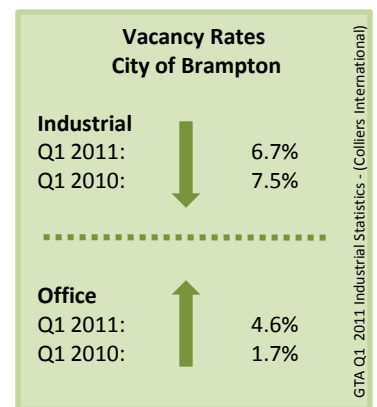
Brampton Building Permits YTD March 2011 (In Thousands)
