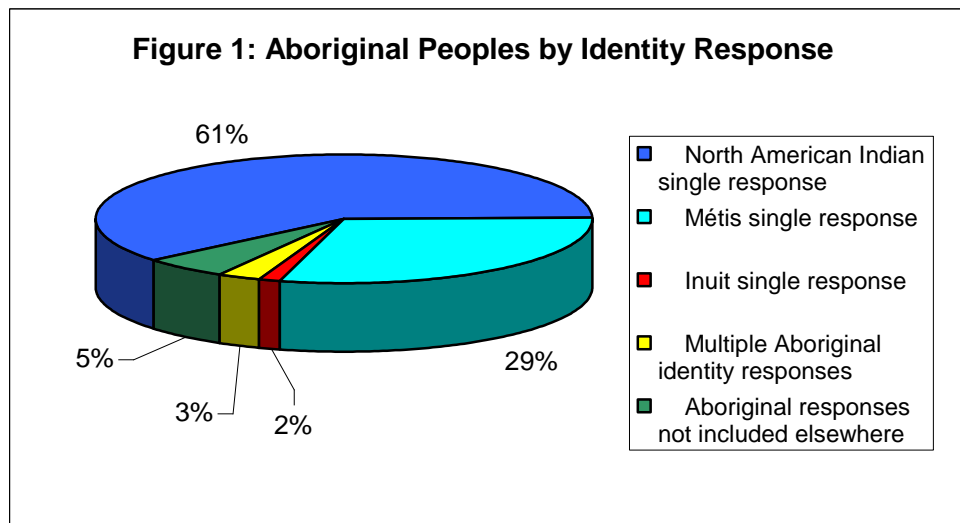

Subject: **Census Bulletin for the City of Brampton (City of Brampton: 2006 Census Population of Aboriginal Peoples)**

The following bulletin is a profile of the Brampton population of Aboriginal Peoples as published by Statistics Canada on January 15, 2008.

Aboriginal Peoples in Brampton

- According to the 2006 Census, 2,665 respondents identified themselves as Aboriginal. This is of 54.94% increase over the 1,720 respondents reported in 2001.
- Female Aboriginals (1,505) continue to out number Males (1,160).



- Of the 2,665 respondents identified as Aboriginal, 31.5% (840) were Registered Indian.
