The Provincial Growth Plan, "Places to Grow" guides growth over the next 25 years for all municipalities within the Greater Golden Horseshoe. Over the past two years the City has been working towards the preparation of an Official Plan amendment to implement the Provincial Growth Plan. This process included the preparation of background studies and discussion papers and was undertaken with extensive public engagement. A draft Official Plan amendment has now been prepared to comply with the Growth Plan.

In accordance with the *Planning Act*, the City of Brampton would like to invite all community members and stakeholders to a Public Open House to review the draft Official Plan amendment, related background material, and ask questions of City staff.
