TRANSPORTATION & TRANSIT MASTER PLAN (TTMP) NOTICE OF STUDY COMPLETION

Dated: July 7, 2004

The City of Brampton has completed a Transportation & Transit Master Plan following Phases 1 and 2 of the Municipal Class Environmental Assessment process (Municipal Engineers Association, June 2000), as approved under the Ontario Environmental Assessment Act. This process will allow the City to proceed confidently with the recommendations of the Master Plan.

Based on the study findings and input from technical agencies and the public, the recommended Master Plan will deliver a long term strategy to effectively and efficiently accommodate Brampton's transportation needs, with particular attention to increasing and improving the role of transit, as the City expands to over 650,000 people by 2030.

A *TTMP Final Report June 2004* has been prepared based on transportation analysis and findings, and on public input that has been received through the course of the study. The Final Report documents the analysis completed and focuses on strategic transportation and transit needs including recommendations for road and transit network plans for the 2011, 2021, and 2031 horizon years as well as specific policies and programs targeted at optimizing the City's transportation system. Key recommendations include:

- **Continued expansion of the City's road infrastructure;**
- **Evolution of transit to a comprehensive grid-based system with higher service frequencies and enhanced connectivity within and beyond Brampton;**
- **Implementation of the AcceleRide bus rapid transit (BRT) initiative on Queen Street and Main Street in the short-term, and expansion to other major corridors.**

While the Master Plan addresses need and justification at a broad level, more detailed studies for each of the projects included in the Master Plan will be completed at a later date as required by the Municipal Class EA.
