Re: Transportation & Transit Master Plan Sustainable Update

Thank you for your past participation and continued interest in the City of Brampton's *Transportation & Transit Master Plan (TTMP) Sustainable Update*.

The *TTMP Sustainable Update* is a strategic planning document to guide the implementation of transportation investments, policies and actions aimed at achieving a sustainable, balanced future transportation network that will meet the City's needs until 2031 and beyond. The *TTMP Sustainable Update* has been prepared on behalf of the City by HDR iTRANS Consultants as a Master Plan consistent with Phases 1 and 2 of the Municipal Class Environmental Assessment.

Last summer, Brampton Council approved in principle the Draft Final *TTMP Sustainable Update*, pending a formal public review. In November 2009, a Notice of Study Completion was issued and the Final Report released for a 30-day public consultation period (that was extended into January 2010). Staff has reviewed, considered, and incorporated as appropriate public and agency comments into a final, revised Master Plan document, which is now being recommended for formal adoption and approval at **Planning, Design & Development Committee on June 21, 2010 at 1:00pm** (Council Chambers, Brampton City Hall, 2 Wellington Street West).

You are welcome to attend the Committee meeting, where you also have an opportunity to voice your support for or concerns with the TTMP and staff's recommendations. 
Please contact the Clerk's Office no later than 4:30pm on the Wednesday of the week before the scheduled meeting to put in a request to be a delegation at the meeting.
