



NOTICE OF STUDY COMPLETION Transportation & Transit Master Plan Sustainable Update

The City of Brampton has prepared a Master Plan following Phases 1 and 2 of the Municipal Class Environmental Assessment (October 2000, as amended in 2007), which is an approved process under the Ontario Environmental Assessment Act. Master Plans are long-range plans that integrate infrastructure requirements for existing and future land uses with environmental assessment principles. While the Master Plan addresses need and justification at a broad city-wide level, more detailed studies related to some infrastructure components of the Master Plan are expected to be undertaken at a later date as part of Municipal Class EAs for other City and Region of Peel infrastructure projects.

The study area for the Transportation & Transit Master Plan (TTMP) includes all of the City of Brampton. The TTMP Sustainable Update is a platform to move forward with the implementation of the transportation vision defined in the City's first TTMP in 2004. It is designed to be a strategic planning document that will guide the implementation of transportation investments, policies and actions aimed at achieving a sustainable, balanced future transportation network that will meet the City's needs until 2031 and beyond. The TTMP Update reaffirms the City's commitment to sustainable development, protection of the natural environment, economic vitality, and healthy communities - and at the same time provides safe, affordable, and efficient transportation for people and goods. The TTMP incorporates comments received from the public and agencies during the course of the study.

Building on the transportation vision and strategy that was developed in the 2004 TTMP, the 2009 Master Plan provides updated transportation system recommendations that reflect recent growth trends, new planning initiatives at the provincial level and other jurisdictions, and that evaluates solutions for a transportation system in Northwest Brampton area, which was incorporated into the City's urban boundary after the last TTMP. The Master Plan Update study also provides the necessary transportation infrastructure timing for the purposes of the City's DC By-law update completed in August 2009. The TTMP has been an integral part of the City's overall Growth Plan conformity exercise and provides the basis for revisions and input to the transportation components of the Brampton Official Plan.

The draft Transportation & Transit Master Plan was presented to Planning, Design & Development Committee on July 27, 2009, and was approved in principle pending the 30-day public review period that commences with issuance of this Notice. Please take this opportunity to provide your written comments to Mr. Henrik Zbogor at the City of Brampton by December 21, 2009. Thereafter, the Master Plan will be reviewed and revised taking into consideration the comments which are received from the public. The recommended Final Transportation & Transit Master Plan will then be presented to City Council for approval and formal adoption.
