

City of Brampton Open House Vales of the Humber Secondary Plan/Block Plan

The City of Brampton is pleased to invite you to attend an Open House for the planning of the Vales of Humber Secondary Plan. The Vales of Humber is bounded by Mayfield Road to the North, Countryside Drive to the south, The Gore Road to the east and the West Humber River to the west.

In October 2005, City Council adopted an Official Plan Amendment that redesignated the Vales of the Humber (Secondary Plan Area 50) from Estate Residential to Residential and identified the lands as a new upscale executive residential housing area.

In December 2009, a staff report presented a preferred land use concept, community vision and planning principles to Council for endorsement and received direction to initiate block planning.

The City, in consultation with the Vales of Humber Landowners Group, have prepared a preliminary block plan concept based on the findings of the various background studies as well as the feedback from the June 23, 2009 open house.

The purpose of this second open house is to present the preliminary block plan and secondary plan concept for review by local area residents and stakeholders prior to proceeding to a statutory public meeting in the future. In attendance will be representatives from the Landowners Group, City staff and the Area Councillors to hear your feedback and answer questions.

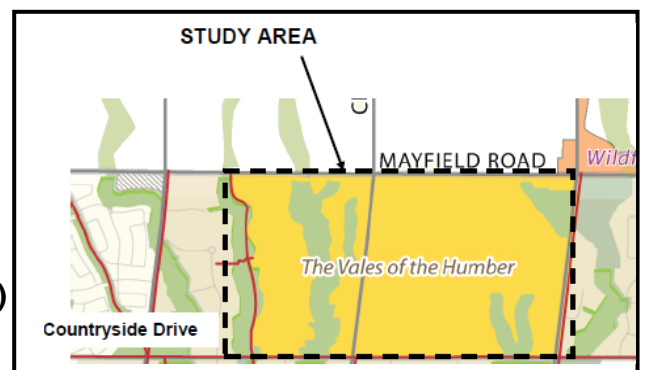
