## **Stakeholder Update #10**

Dear Stakeholders,

We are writing to remind you that Brampton Brick has initiated the 45-day public notification period, as part of its application for an aggregate licence under the Aggregate Resources Act. A public information session hosted by Brampton Brick is scheduled for Tuesday, November 30, 2010 (a copy of the Notice is also available on the City's website).

Objections may be filed during the 45-day notification period, which closes on **Monday, December 20, 2010**. Objections to the Ministry can be made in writing or via email to [AggRes@Ontario.ca](mailto:AggRes@Ontario.ca). Email objections must contain a postal address or they will not be considered acceptable. A copy of the objection must also be sent to Brampton Brick, in writing, by pre-paid regular mail by December 20, 2010.
