

**Surplus Declaration of Property and Conveyance to Region of Peel

LANDS AFFECTED

4494 Ebenezer Road, described as Part lot 6 Concession 9, City of Brampton (formerly Township of Toronto Gore), Regional Municipality of Peel, designated as Parts 1 and 2 on Reference Plan 43R-33525

EXPLANATORY NOTE

The lands will be transferred to the Region of Peel for road widening purposes.

- Disposal of surplus property or rights at less than current market value to another municipal government in compliance with Standard Operating Procedure for Inter-municipal transactions.
