**EXPLANATORY NOTE**

Conveyance of permanent easement rights to the Region of Peel for the purposes of construction, operation, maintenance, inspection, alteration, removal, reconstruction, enlargement and repair of watermains and related appurtenances in connection with the extension of Cottrelle Blvd.

The City's Real Estate Policy, By-law 98-2008, authorizes delegation of authority to the City Solicitor and an officer of the municipality, in this case, the Commissioner of Community Services, in connection with the following Real Estate related activity:

- Disposal of surplus property rights at current market value of \$50,000 or less, to be conveyed to a utility for installation/maintenance of services, or for property or rights to be conveyed to another government
