NOTICE OF APPLICATION FOR APPROVAL TO EXPROPRIATE LAND BRAMALEA ROAD WIDENING

IN THE MATTER OF an application by **The Corporation of the City of Brampton** for approval to expropriate portions of the lands municipally known as 11651, 11532, 11860, 11556 and R.R. #4 Bramalea Road, in the City of Brampton, in the Regional Municipality of Peel (formerly in the Township of Chinguacousy, County of Peel), for the purpose of widening Bramalea Road from Countryside Drive to Mayfield Road, and the associated relocation of utilities.

NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN that application has been made for approval to expropriate the land described as follows:

The land situated in the City of Brampton, in the Regional Municipality of Peel (formerly in the Township of Chinguacousy, County of Peel), and being described as Parts 5 and 6, Plan 43R-30958, for highway purposes for the widening of Bramalea Road and the associated relocation of utilities;

Parts 30 and 33 on Plan 43R-32491, for a permanent easement for highway purposes, to accommodate hydro guy wires and anchors;

Parts 11, 14, 15, 16 and 17 on Plan 43R-32491, for a permanent easement for highway purposes, to accommodate aerial hydro lines and maintenance, repair and upgrading the aerial lines;

Parts 4, 5, 6, 7, 8 and 9 on Plan 43R-33096 and Parts 11, 12, 13, 14, 15, 16, 17, 30, 33, and 34 on Plan 43R-32491, for a temporary easement, for a period of five (5) years from the date of registration of the expropriation plan, to enter onto the subject lands with workers, material and equipment for the purpose of regrading, shaping, drainage and restoration work; and

Parts 12, 13, 15, 17 and 34 on Plan 43R-32491, for a permanent drainage easement for highway purposes to construct, maintain and upgrade structures for drainage purposes, storm water management and ancillary works.

Any owner of lands in respect of which notice is given who desires an inquiry into whether the taking of such land is fair, sound and reasonably necessary in the achievement of the objectives of the expropriating authority shall so notify the approving authority in writing,

- (a) in the case of the registered owner, served personally or by registered mail, within thirty (30) days after the registered owner is served with the notice, or, when the registered owner is served by publication, within thirty (30) days after the first publication of the notice;
- (b) in the case of an owner who is not a registered owner, within thirty (30) days after the first publication of the notice.

The approving authority is **The Council of the Corporation of the City of Brampton**, 2 Wellington Street, Brampton, ON L6Y 4R2. Authorization By-law 332-2009 as amended by By-law 71-2011.

Plans showing the affected lands are available for review in the City Clerk's office, at the address below, during regular business hours.
